INTRODUCTION

We invite you to visit one of the most beautiful regions of Poland, the Pomerania Region. Its unique locations with health resort qualities utilize natural environmental resources, cultural heritage, and tourist attractions. The region offers a rich health-oriented portfolio for both residents and visitors from across the country and abroad.

We present to you the **Pomeranian Health Guide (PHG)**, which contains comprehensive information about the health services available in the Pomerania Region, along with key places providing emergency assistance. This is the first regional compilation of its kind in Poland. You will find information about both **medical entities** and **tourist attractions**, including **descriptions of selected city parks**.

PHG includes places that save health (hospitals, clinics), help to regain it (rehabilitation centers, hotels), or prevent various ailments and support self-regeneration (green areas and parks).

In the first part of the document, **we invite you to visit our city parks**, which are ideal for supporting health and relaxation in a natural setting. The parks feature equipment to improve fitness and provide active time for children as well. Some of them have health-promoting infrastructure, such as graduation towers or fitness trails.

In the second part, we will showcase **the most frequently visited attractions of our voivodeshi**p from the perspective of people with special health needs.

The third part of the document is a guide with information on accommodation facilities where health services are available. We have also included data on brine pools in our region.

The final part of the guide is useful in **situations of urgent need** for medical services, both for residents and tourists, as well as for pets.

We have made every effort to ensure that the information collected by the end of August 2024 and included in the study is reliable. We plan to update it regularly in the coming years.

We hope that PHG will prove to be a valuable, helpful, and perhaps even inspiring publication for the residents of Pomerania and visitors to this beautiful and unique region.

Urban parks play a vital role in the lives of residents and the functioning of cities. Each park offers something unique, from exercise equipment to artistic installations. Climate change presents new challenges for city dwellers, with increasing heat making parks invaluable oases that save us from the heat and urban hustle.

Below, you will find descriptions of 25 parks located in the Pomeranian Region. They have been selected based on their exceptional development features. Some of these places do not have official names, but due to their charm, they have been included here. The icons next to the descriptions indicate the character of the park and the elements that can be found there.

Parks vary in character, location, and infrastructure. The vast majority offer exercise equipment, but you can also find unique elements such as hammocks for lounging or impressive sculptures. We invite you to discover them!



LEGEND

Each park is described using blue icons if at least one element of that type is present in the park.

Green icons indicate the rating of a particular element on a three-star scale. For forestation, the density and height of trees were considered. Playground ratings were based on their size and the variety of equipment. Healthiness ratings took into account factors such as air quality and monitoring, water resources, noise levels, and health infrastructure.





1 Park A. Majkowskiego

Wejherowo, Parkowa street

The most diverse park in terms of the quantity and quality of amenities and attractions in the region. Beautifully situated on the edge of the city near a forest, the park is interesting and well-maintained, with a clear reference to Kashubian culture. A wide range of dining options is available.

































2 Park Ronalda Regana

Gdańsk, Piastowska street



The largest urban park in Gdańsk offers a variety of attractions for people of all ages. Located along the beach, it includes a coastal forest and green areas. The park features numerous playgrounds, exercise areas, and art installations. Fruit trees are also a part of the park's landscape. It's an ideal spot for a family picnic, thanks to the available barbecue areas.

WEJHEROWO 1 GDAŃSK

Błonia Sopockie

Sopot, Bitwy pod Płowcami street



A park with a distinctly health-promoting character, featuring a graduation tower, sensory garden, and a "barefoot path." Attractively located near the beach and sea, this new park is still moderately forested. The main issues are the poor quality of the paths leading to the attractions and the lack of information about them.

Park Kultury i Wypoczynku

Słupsk, J. Słowackiego street

A very charming park with a modern playground and access to the Słupia River. The park features a kayaking route, a modern restroom, a café, and numerous opportunities for active leisure.

































A beautiful forest park adorned with hydrangeas, reflecting Kashubian traditions, equipped with hammocks and a fitness trail with exercise equipment. The park features a trail of wooden sculptures inspired by Kashubian legends, with translations in three languages. There are two modern restrooms available. The sports infrastructure is also located in the area adjacent to the park, but it is not forested. Additionally, there is a shelter with a fire pit.

6 Park Oruński E. Hoene

Gdańsk, Raduńska street

This historical park is situated along the picturesque Oruński Stream, where you can walk all the way to the Augustowska Reservoir. Due to its dense forestation and hilly terrain, it is an attractive area all year round. It is excellent for running and active recreation. The park also houses cultural institutions.

The second largest park in Gdańsk, gradually expanded and equipped, making it an attractive place for active recreation. Beautifully located in a valley around retention reservoirs















Below is a brief description of the 20 most visited tourist attractions in the Pomerania Region in 2023 (research conducted by the regional authorities of the Pomerania Region) in terms of their accessibility.

The icons next to the attractions are based on information declared on the official websites of the respective locations. Additionally, each attraction is accompanied by a comment regarding its accessibility.

Europejskie Centrum Solidarności pl. Solidarności 1, 80-863 Gdańsk



A modern museum and educational center dedicated to the history of the Solidarity movement and the democratic transformations in Poland and Central and Eastern Europe.

A facility with numerous amenities for people with disabilities. It is accessible, allowing free movement across different levels. Care has been taken to accommodate individuals with various impairments. It features a unique amenity: a tactile light sculpture for visually impaired individuals.

Molo w Sopocie

Plac Zdrojowy 2, 81-723 Sopot



A landmark of the city, consisting of the Kuracyjny Square and a wooden pier extending 511.5 meters into the Gdańsk Bay.

The attraction is outdoors. It is very popular among locals and tourists. There is no designated parking nearby. The pier is located by the sea, and the area is noisy and busy. It is a flat, wooden structure that allows for easy movement.

The largest brick castle built by the Teutonic Order in the world. Additionally, it serves as a museum and an educational-research. institution.

The historic building is only partially adapted to modern accessibility requirements. The castle, which is the main attraction of the museum, is very challenging for people with mobility impairments. Only the ticket and sanitary building has many amenities. The castle can be visited with a guide dog.

Zoo w Gdańsku

Karwieńska 3. 80-328 Gdańsk



A zoo located in the heart of the Tricity Landscape Park. It was established in 1954 and covers an area of 125 hectares, housing animals from all continents

The attraction is outdoors and located in a hilly area, partially within a forest. Due to the presence of many animals, there may be a high intensity of various sensory stimuli. There are no stairs on the premises, so ramps are not necessary. The facility features a tactile map for visually impaired individuals.

Muzeum II Wojny Światowej

Plac Władysława Bartoszewskiego 1, 80-862 Gdańsk



A museum dedicated to World War II, one of the largest in Europe on this topic. It presents, among other things, the fate of civilians, including the experiences of the Polish nation.

A modern and spacious museum that allows for comfortable movement. Visiting can be quite demanding due to the size of the exhibition. There is the possibility to borrow tactile book plans and to visit with an assistance dog. Special tactile paths are available on all levels.

The Gdańsk Museums consist of eleven branches with different characters and collections. The most frequently visited places are the Main Town Hall, the Amber Museum, and the Artus Court. The first showcases the history and development of the city of Gdańsk, the second focuses on the charms of amber, and the third is a representative room with numerous works of art and the largest tiled stove in Europe.

One of the 23 national parks in Poland, located on the Baltic Sea. It was established to protect the dune belt of the spit with unique moving dunes, exceptional in all of Europe.

ERGO ARENA

Plac Dwóch Miast 1, 80-344 Gdańsk



A modern entertainment and sports hall located on the border of Gdańsk and Sopot. It can accommodate up to 15,000 spectators.

An interdisciplinary institution located on the grounds of the former Fort Góra Gradowa in Gdańsk. It combines elements of education, history, culture, and recreation.

The attraction is located on Góra Gradowa, which is quite difficult to access on foot. The historic buildings and fortifications have been adapted to a limited extent. However, most exhibitions are accessible to people with various disabilities. Additional amenities include available films with subtitles and a special guide on information about exhibits with a high number of sensory stimuli.

A modern football stadium opened in 2011. It can accommodate 41,200 spectators.

The venue is designed for a variety of events, primarily sports. There are special sections and seating areas for individuals with disabilities and their caregivers. Guide dogs are allowed in the stadium. The premises have a large number of stairs.

One of the oldest cultural institutions in Poland, it is housed in the buildings of a former Franciscan monastery. The museum boasts rich collections of paintings, sculptures, goldsmithing, and ceramics.

The museum comprises several branches. The main headquarters is located in a historic building with limited accessibility. Entry to the building requires special assistance due to the historic doors. Inside, there are ramps, but moving between levels can be challenging and is recommended with a companion. Digital tours are available. The best-adapted branches for the needs of individuals with disabilities are the NOMUS Modern Art Department and the Gdańsk Gallery of Photography.

A memorial site of the former German Nazi concentration camp. The museum covers approximately 20 hectares of the former camp grounds.

One of the city's most important cultural institutions, located in the historic building of a former power plant. The philharmonic hosts a variety of concerts, recitals, and cultural events







Night and holiday healthcare services

Night and holiday healthcare services provide primary healthcare from Monday to Friday between 6:00 PM and 8:00 AM the next day, and 24 hours a day on public holidays. In case of sudden illness or a sudden deterioration of health, a patient can seek help at any night and holiday healthcare service point, regardless of where they live or which primary healthcare doctor/nurse (POZ) they have registered with.

800 190 590 - Patient Information Telephone Service (TIP)

A free, 24/7 telephone service providing information on various healthcare services, including night and holiday healthcare. Information is also available in English.

Every primary healthcare provider (family doctor) is required to display the addresses and phone numbers of entities providing services after 6:00 PM and on public holidays inside the clinic (visible from the outside as well).
